### **I SAMUEL 1:11**

#### ***Hannah Prayed***

“And she vowed avow and said, O lord of hosts, If thou wilt indeed look on the affliction of thine handmaid, and remember me, not forget thine handmaid, but wilt give unto thine handmaid a man child, then I will give him unto the Lord all the days of his life, and there shall n razor come upon his head.”

#### **God Answered**

### **II CHRONICLES 20:3, 6,9**

***Jehoshaphat Prayed*** – reminded God of how great He is; how powerful He is; there is none like Him.

“Jehoshaphat said, O Lord God of our fathers, art not thou God in heaven? And rulest not thou over all the kingdoms of the heathen? And in thine hand is there not power and might, so that none is able to withstand thee?

### **II KING 20:1-3**

“In those days was Hezekiah sick unto death. And the prophet Isaiah the son of Amos came to him, and said unto him, Thus saith the Lord, Set thine house in order; for thou shalt die and not live.”

**Hezekiah Prayed** – reminded God of who he (Hezekiah was)

**II CHRONICLES 6:19**

**Solomon Prayed**

"Have respect therefore to the prayer of thy servant and to his supplication, O Lord my God, to hearken unto the cry and the prayer which thy servant prayeth before thee: That thine eyes may be open upon this house day and night, upon the place where of thou hast said that thou wouldest put thy name there; to hearken unto the prayer which thy servant prayeth toward this place ...when thou **hearest FORGIVE.**"

**God Answered 7:14**

"If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."

**ACTS 16:25**
